### Parking Lot Safety

Students should not be dropped off at school in the morning before 7:55 am. If your student is dropped off before that time, they will be sent to the Extended Day Program. Parents will be charged for unscheduled drop-ins. Please wait in your car with your student until there is adult supervision in the parking lot.

**Please observe the entrance and exit signs and drive very safely and slowly (5 mph) for the safety of all the children. Never back up in the parking lot.**

### Medication

If your child is required to take any medication, (this includes cough syrup, Tylenol allergy medicine) it is necessary that a parental consent form and physician consent form be completed before any medication may be administered. These forms must be updated each year and are available in the school office.

**NO MEDICATION will be administered without written consent on the appropriate forms (this includes inhalers).**

For everyone's safety no child is permitted to keep medication with them, an exception is made for inhalers if necessary for students above third grade. All medication is kept in the school office.

### Brown Envelope

Please sign your student's brown envelope and return it to the classroom teacher. **Each time your brown envelope comes home you will need to empty it, sign it and return it to the classroom teacher.**

Your brown envelope will come home with bills and information that will need to be returned to the office. Please return your signed brown envelope the next day. It is difficult to send home information if we do not have your brown envelope.

Enclosed you will find a parent/student contract. After you read the handbook, please have your student and you sign the contract and return it to the classroom teacher by August 23<sup>rd</sup>.
