

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST 2011 - 2012

The majority of school supplies will be shared among the children.

6- #2 pencils – yellow only

2–Large Boxes Kleenex

2 – Boxes Crayola Crayons – 8 count (8 only)

1 – Pkg. Crayola marker, 8 count (classic colors with wide tip) (8 only)

1 – Set watercolors

4– Glue sticks

1 – Package Dark Blue Construction Paper

Waterless hand sanitizer (optional)

Simple puzzles (optional)

Coloring books (optional)

Wet Wipes (optional)

Book Bag or Back Pack - **NO BACKPACKS ON WHEELS!**

2 - Pocket Folders (pockets on bottom of folder)

1 – Oversized shirt for painting

All supplies should be brought the first day of school.

This includes your child's backpack and folders. Please note that we do use these items up.

They will need to be replaced throughout the school year (mostly crayons and glue sticks).

Crayons, markers, paints & pencils will be shared among all students-DO NOT label with name.

FIRST GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2011-2012

- 1 - Box #2 pencils at least 6 sharpened (yellow only)
- 1- Full size boxes of Kleenex
- 1 – Plastic school box
- 1 – Book bag or backpack - **NO BACKPACKS ON WHEELS**
- 4 – School folders (pockets on bottom of folder). Print your child's name clearly on outside of folder.
- 2 – Pink Pearl Erasers
- 1 – Box Colored Chalk
- 4 – Glue sticks
- 1 – Small bottle Elmer's Glue
- 1 – Set scissors with pointed ends
- 4 – Box Crayola Crayons (24 count – regular colors only)
- 1 – Set watercolors
- 1 – Coloring Book
- 1 – Package Crayola **washable markers classic colors**, the larger size markers, not pencil size – regular colors only – NO EXCEPTIONS
- 1 – Oversized Short Sleeve shirt for painting with child's name clearly marked on shirt
- 1 – Container baby wipes
- 2 – Small dry erase pencil size markers

All supplies should be brought in on the day of 1st grade open house. Everything except for pencils, coloring books, wipes and Kleenex **must be labeled with your child's name** this includes folders, and backpacks. All classroom supplies will need to be replaced as needed throughout the school year (mostly crayons, glue sticks, pencils and erasers).

I have been specific about certain items because I have found they work best. Please purchase items that match. Thank you.

SECOND GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2011 – 2012

- 1 – Pair scissors with pointed ends
- 3 – Stretch book covers (Please these colors only: 1-Solid red, 1-Solid green, 1-Solid blue)
- 1 – Pencil box (**no larger than 3x5x8 inches**)
- 1 – Box crayons (24 count) washable Crayola – No larger than 24 count
- 1 – Box Markers (8 count) washable
- 1 – Package pencil top erasers. These will be stored at school.
- 1 – Glue stick
- 1 – Small bottle Elmers Glue (4 oz.)
- 2 – Folders with pockets on bottom
 - Put name on outside of each folder
 - Inside front cover label stating, “Stay at School”
 - Inside front cover of 2nd folder label stating, “Go Home”
- 2 – Spiral type (8” x 10 1/2”) wide rule notebooks (**non-perforated, preferred**)
- 1 – Box Kleenex (large)
- 24 - #2 pencils (I will keep these for them) **sharpen all pencils to be ready for use**
- 1 – Old cotton sock to be used as an eraser or dry marker erasers
- 1 – Wet Wipes-disinfecting type for students with last names beginning A-L
- 1 – Wet Wipes-antibacterial for students with last names beginning M-Z
- 1 – Black dry erase maker – fine point works best
- 1 – Set watercolors – 8 count (not fluorescent)
- 1 – Oversized shirt for painting (contained in ziplock bag for storage in desk)
- 1 – Ream computer paper 8 X 11
- 1 – Package Black Construction Paper

Each student will need 25 pennies, 20 nickles, 20 dimes, 4 quarters, 1 – \$1 bill sent in a sturdy ziplock bag without zipper mechanism labeled with the student’s name on the outside.

All supplies must be brought the 1st day of school. Everything except pencils, erasers and Kleenex must have your child’s name on it. This includes your child’s lunch box, folders, and backpack. Please note that we do use these items up. They will need to be replaced as needed throughout the year (mostly crayons and glue sticks).

Please label all uniform clothing with permanent marker.

THIRD GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2011-2012

PLEASE PRINT FIRST & LAST NAME ON ALL SCHOOL SUPPLIES WITH A PERMANENT BLACK MARKER.
